Summary:

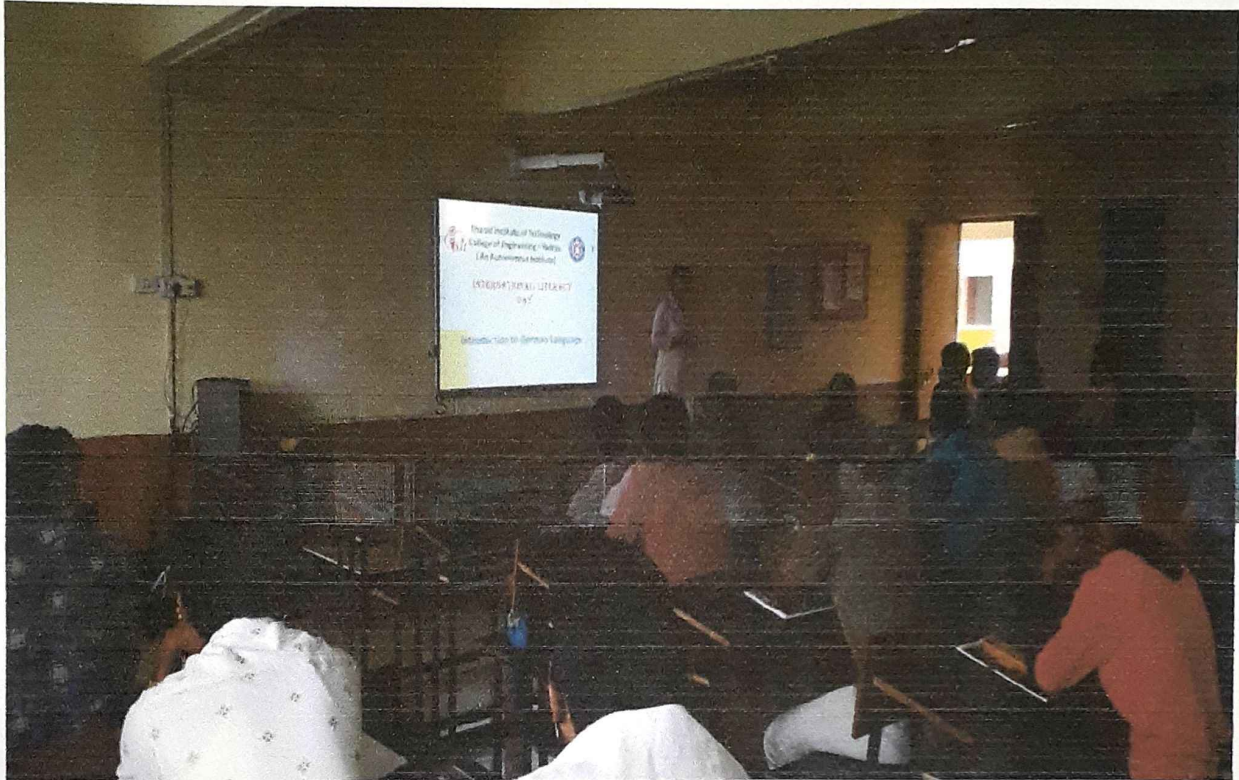


