He also stressed on the identification of weak and bright students.

3. Preparations for Extension of NBA Accreditation of Computer Science and Engineering and Mechanical Engineering Courses.

Mr. Pravin H Yadav, Institute NBA Co-ordinator presented the preparedness regarding extension of NBA accreditation of two programs namely Computer Science and Engineering and Mechanical Engineering and informed that committee visit for the same has been scheduled on 21st May 2022. He also stated that all faculty members are striving hard for the extension of NBA accreditation for the said programs.



4. Application for AICTE EOA 2022-23

Principal informed all hon'ble members about AICTE EOA (Extension of Approval) application for AY 2022-23. He highlighted that Institute has applied for following revision in the Intake for Academic 2022-23 to AICTE, New Delhi.

1. Increase in Intake in Computer Science and Engineering Course from 120 to 180 Intake.
2. Reduction in Civil Engineering Course from 120 to 60 Intake.

Hon'ble member Prof. Padha raised the concern about existing faculty. Prof. S M Pore asked about the need of intake change and preparedness of infrastructure and faculty. Subsequently Principal Dr. Khot shared the policy of the management that not to terminate any existing faculty. Only they can be transferred to our Polytechnic.
